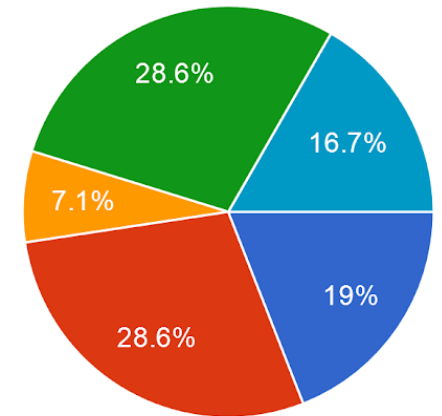


Dat Alumni-Survey on Data Management

In the course of the DAAD funded project [DatAlumni](#), an online survey was conducted.

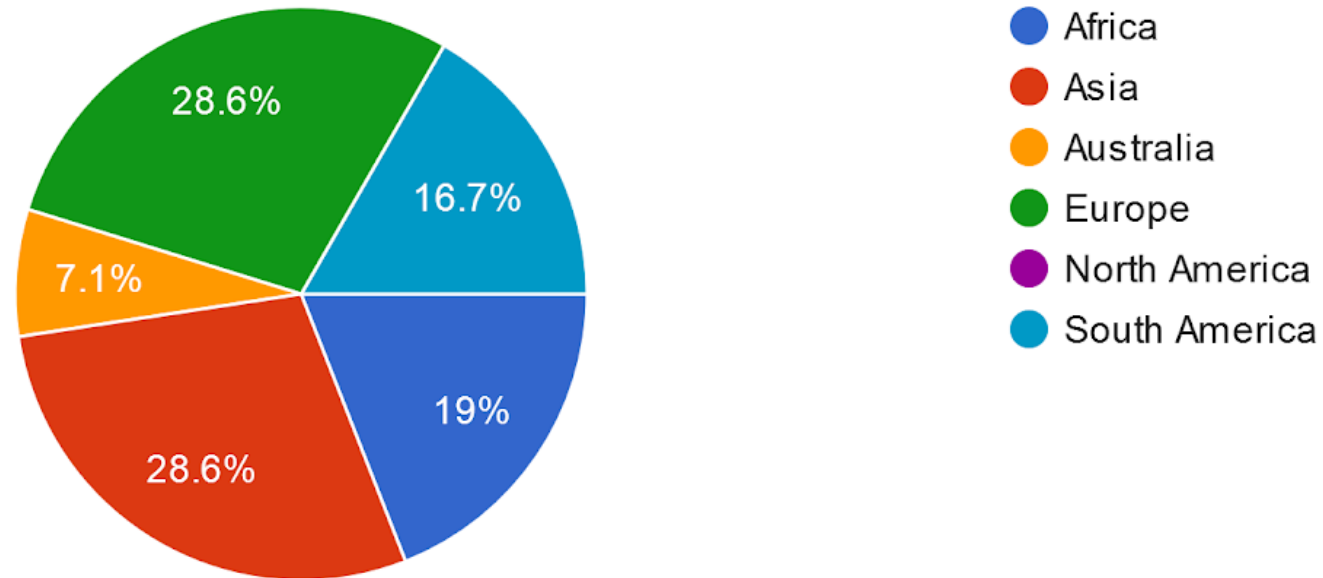
We wanted to learn about the data management and data literacy competences of ZMT Alumni, as well identify challenges and needs when managing data.

The following slides summarize the outcome of this survey.

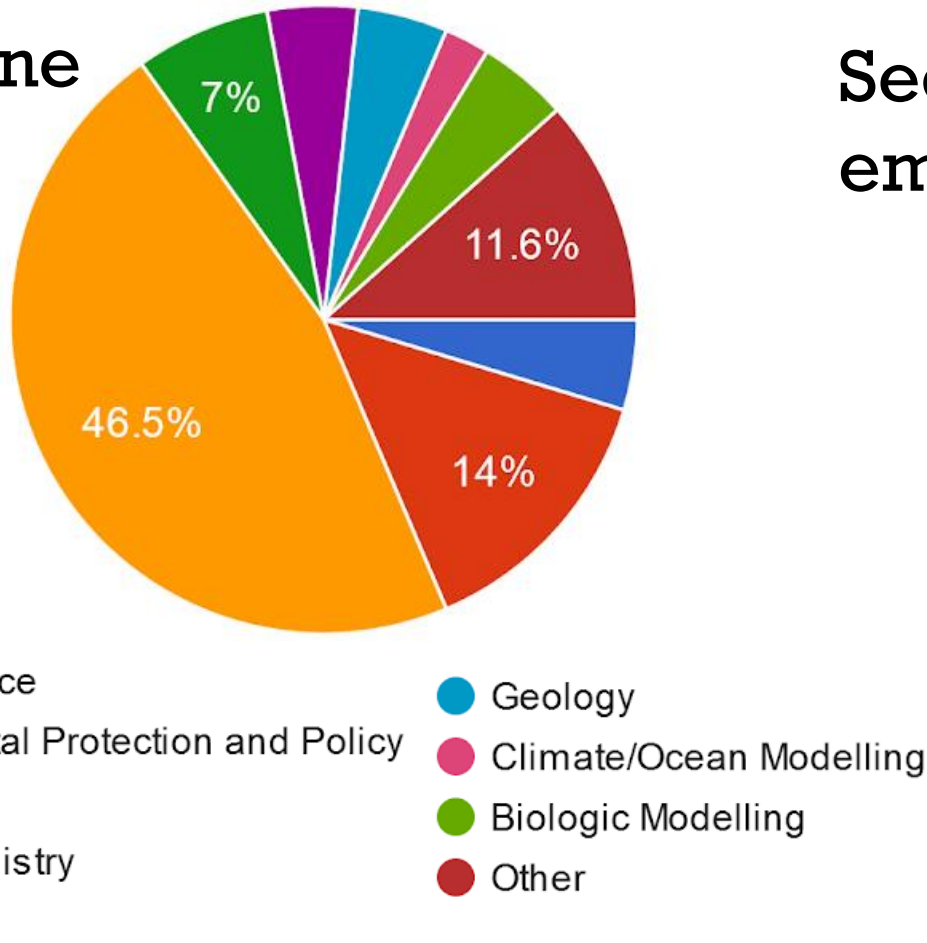


Which is your continent of residence?

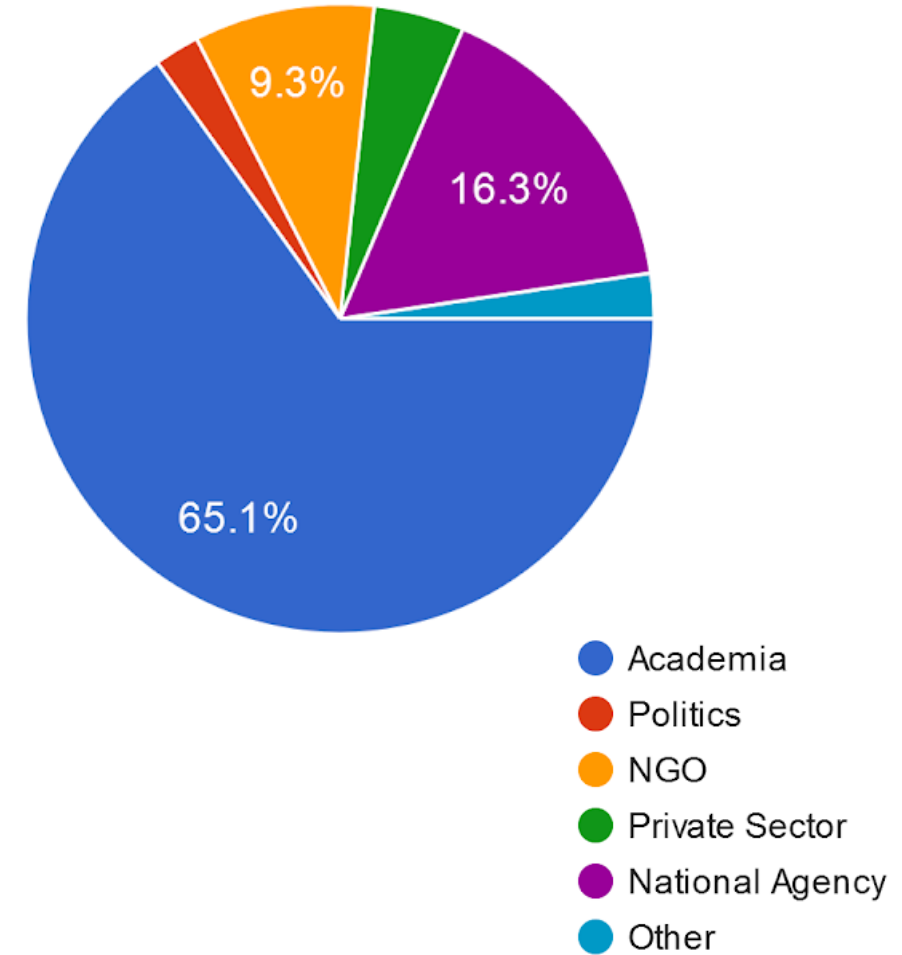

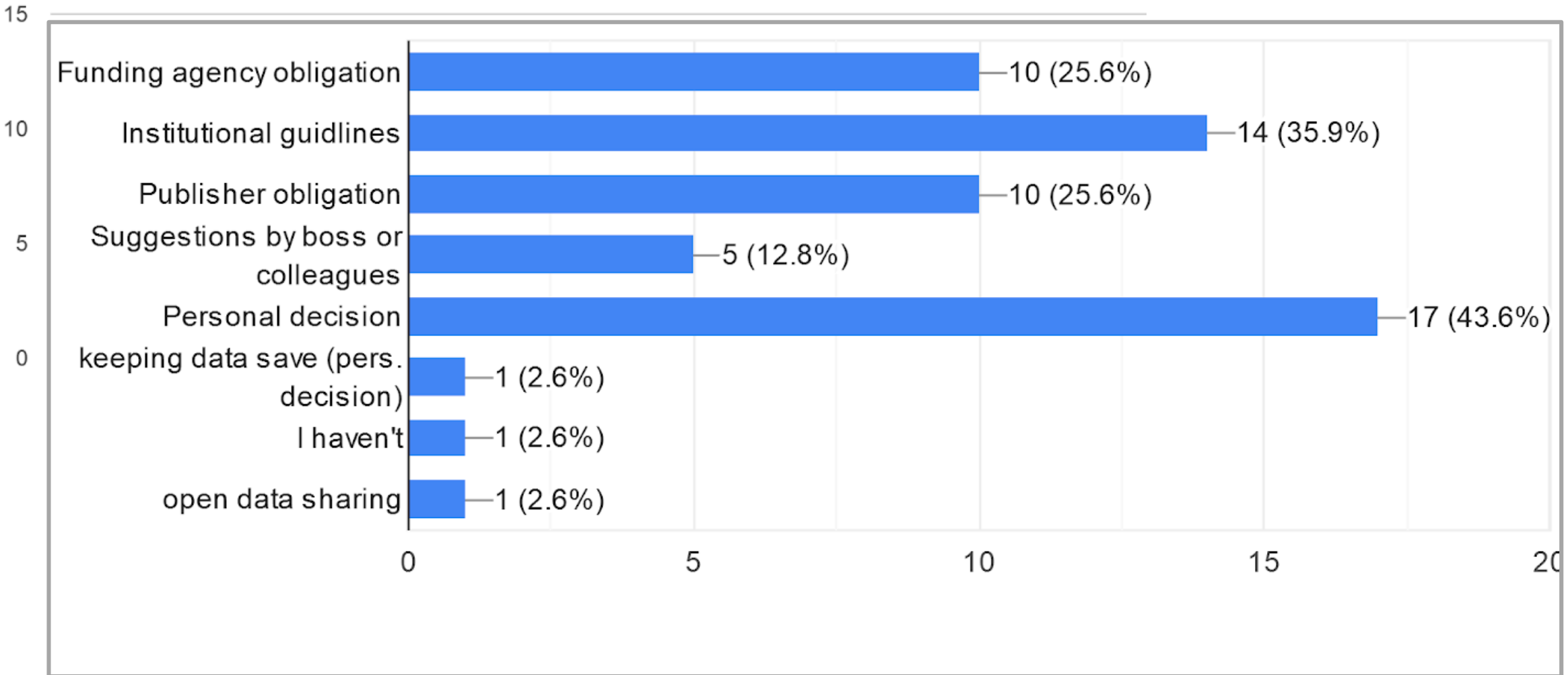
Discipline



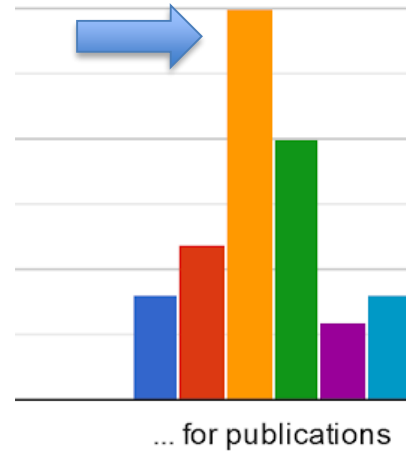
Sector of employment



Why do you store your data in repositories?

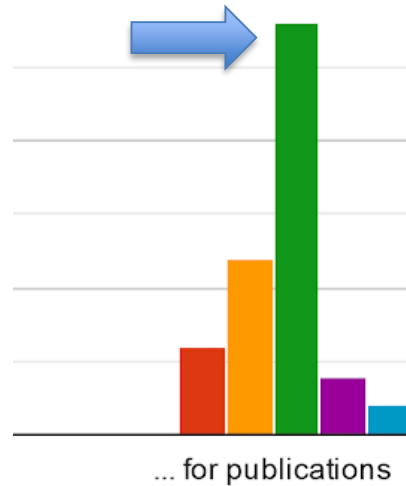

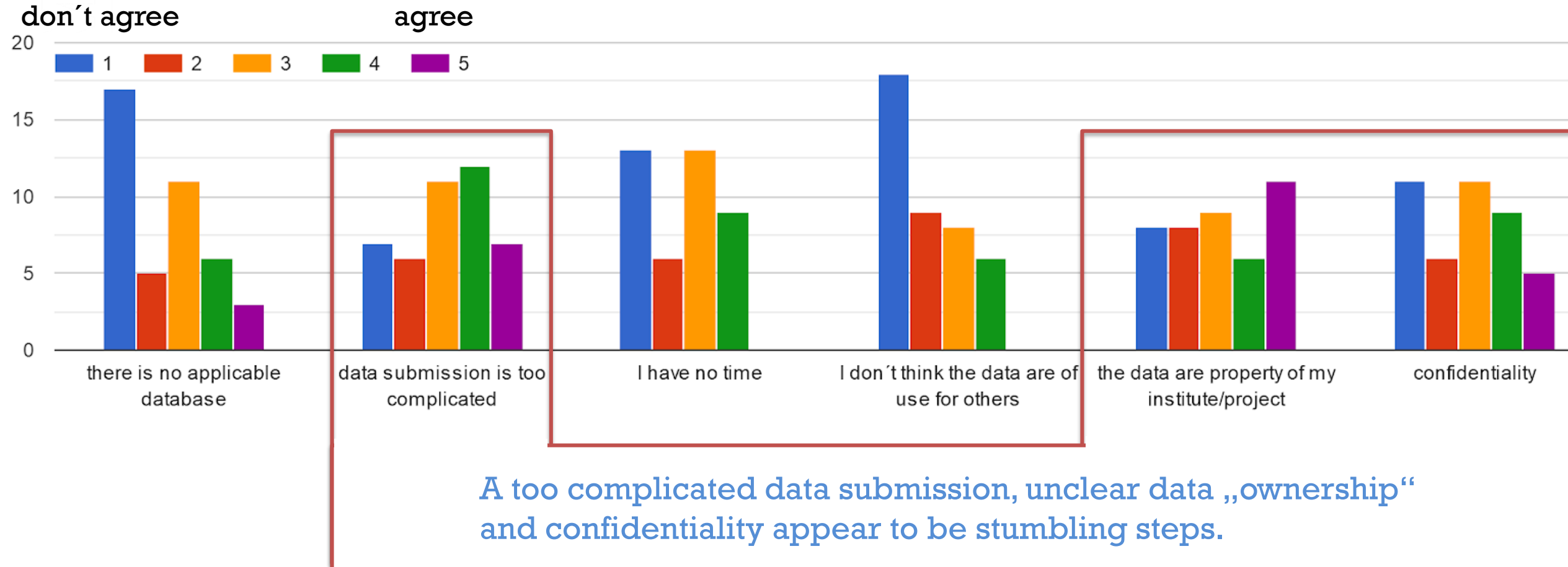
The participants indicate that they use data from repositories less often, than they think is common in their discipline.

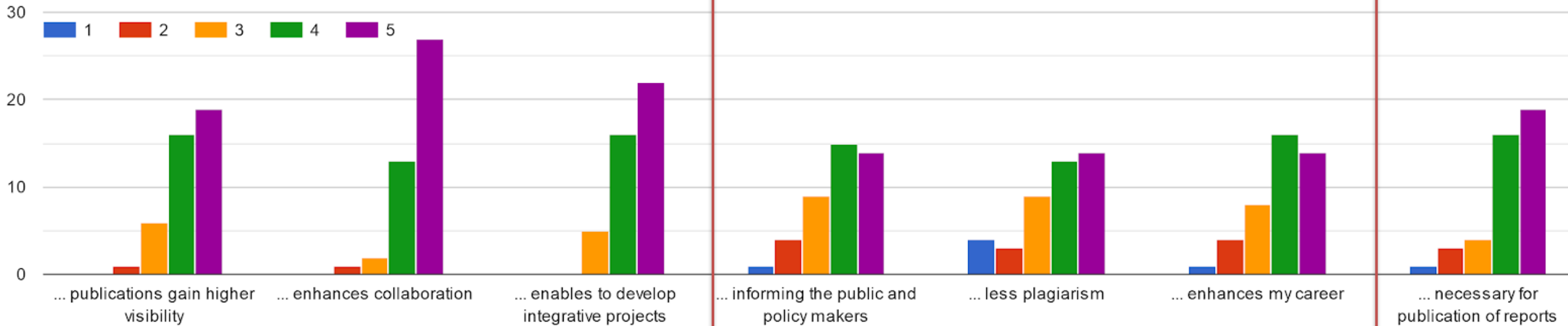
